FICTITIOUS BUSINESS STATEMENT PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The California Business and Professions Codes requires that Fictitious Business Names Statements be published as follows:

- Statements must be published once a week, for 4 consecutive weeks in a newspaper
 of general circulation in the county where the fictitious business name was filed.
- Publication must begin within 45 days of the date of filing the Statement.
- If the registrant has no place of business in this State, the notice must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Sacramento County.
- An Affidavit of publication must be filed with our office within 45 days of completion
 of the publication (the affidavit is normally sent to our office by the newspaper—you may
 want to confirm that the paper you choose provides this service.)
- If you are renewing a previous statement and there are no changes, the Statement does not need to be published.
- Statements of Abandonment must be published in the same manner as above.
- Statements of Withdrawal from Partnerships must be published in the same manner as above unless a notice of dissolution of the partnership has been published pursuant to Section 15035.5 of the Corporations Code.
