SUBJECT: WINTER 2022-2023 ATMOSPHERIC RIVER STORM

In response to Governor Newsom's disaster proclamation on January 16, 2023, the Assessor-Recorder-County Clerk's office is providing emergency support to community members impacted by the winter storms.

Pursuant to this Proclamation of a State of Emergency, fees for certified copies of birth, death, marriage, and dissolution of marriage records are suspended for any individual in San Joaquin County who lost such records as a result of the winter storm. This Proclamation will remain in effect until the Governor terminates the State of Emergency. Please contact our office at (209) 468-3939 or via email at recorder@sjgov.org, if you have questions.

Property owners in San Joaquin County that have sustained damages as a result of the Atmospheric River Storm may be eligible for a temporary reduction in the assessed value of their property or be eligible to retain their Proposition 13 base year value if they rebuild or relocate. Additionally, property owners may be eligible for deferral of payment of their current property taxes in instances where they pay property taxes independently of their mortgage company.
