SUBJECT: TREE REMOVAL AT 1235 WEST SHERIDAN WAY

Dear Property Owner:

Due to the condition of the tree located within the San Joaquin County (County) right-of-way in front of your property, the Department of Public Works (Public Works) will remove the tree in the near future.

County policy regarding tree removal is to cut the trunk as low as possible without damaging the chainsaws. The wood will be left in proximity of the tree stump. This potential firewood is then available on a first-come basis. Public Works will neither remove the stump, nor replace the tree. However, property owners may remove the stump and/or replace the tree at their expense.
