



# Colonial Heights & Lincoln Village Water Main Replacement Project Phase 1A

Dear Resident,

The San Joaquin County Department of Public Works is excited to announce a forthcoming infrastructure improvement project in your neighborhood. In general, this project will include installation of approximately 11,500 linear feet of new water mains, along with new service laterals, fire hydrants, and meter boxes within the Colonial Heights and Lincoln Village Maintenance Districts. This project will not include installation of any meters.

### **Project Timeline**

#### **COLONIAL HEIGHTS**

- Anticipated Construction Start: May 5, 2025
- Estimated Duration: 13 weeks
- Preparatory work, including project layout and potholing to locate underground utilities, may take place prior to the official construction start date.

#### LINCOLN VILLAGE

- Anticipated Construction Start: August 6, 2025
- Estimated Duration: 13 weeks
- Limited work on Gettysburg Place, along with preparatory activities such as project layout and potholing to locate underground utilities, may take place prior to the official construction start date.

NOTE: There may be some overlap in work between the two locations, with construction activities potentially occurring in both areas simultaneously.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Some roads may be temporarily closed to through traffic; however, residential access will always be maintained.
- Parking and driveway access may be restricted during construction activities; however, full access will be available at night.
- Brief interruptions to water service may occur as final connections are made and cleaning operations are completed.
- The contractor will provide advance notification of any planned service disruptions.
