MHSA – Community Services and Supports Project Based Housing and Homelessness Initiatives

Project Based Housing:

- Agreement with Housing Authority of San Joaquin
- Total of 35 housing units
- Term: 20 years
- Funding: MHSA \$3.5 Million
- Target Population: Individuals with mental illness



Project Description:

- Renovate existing office buildings into new housing units for individuals with mental illnesses with onsite supportive services.
- Dedicated to house individuals with mental health concerns for at least 20 years.
- Housing vouchers are attached to the unit, not the tenant, which ensures the facility will retain its purpose and focus on this population.

Current Status:

 Phase I Crossways Residences at 448 S. Center St. are undergoing renovation.

Other Homelessness Initiatives:

Whole Person Care:

- Provide intensive case management and wrap around services for clients
- Projected Clients Served: 500
- Target Population: Adults enrolled in Medi-Cal who are homeless or at risk of homelessness
- Term 5 years (2016-2020)
- Access to medical respite and recuperative care component 15 beds at Gospel Rescue Mission



MHSA Innovation Programs –

- Homeward Bound
 - Projected Clients Served 1,000
 - \$250K for housing supports to increase the availability of housing for individuals with mental illnesses
 - Aligns with the recommendations of the County's Homelessness Taskforce and the Stepping-up Initiative Steering Committee



MHSA Innovation Programs –

- Progressive Housing

 - Target Population: Homeless individuals with mental illness
 - Clients Served:
 - 2018/2019: 50 clients
 - 2019/2020 projected: 100 clients
