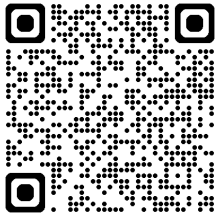

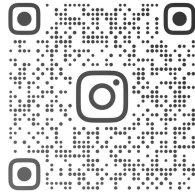
## Safe Camping
