Robert Rickman Marks the 48th anniversary of National Ag Day Tuesday, March 23, 2021

STOCKTON – San Joaquin County's Fifth District Supervisor Robert Rickman marks the 48th anniversary of National Ag Day and acknowledges a local congressman's visit to the San Joaquin County Agricultural Center with this statement;

"I am proud to celebrate America's Farmers on National Ag Day. This year's theme is "Food Brings Everyone to the Table."

Here in San Joaquin County, agriculture is our economy's top industry and is as integral to our future as it is to our region's legacy. The reported estimated gross value of agricultural production for 2019 was \$2,617,815,000. We recognize our agriculture industry's importance with the support of an interactive Ag Commissioner's Office, an active Ag Advisory Board, and a strong Right to Farm Ordinance. San Joaquin County AgVenture is a county-sponsored agriculture and nutrition education program for youth in San Joaquin County.
