Discussion to Allocate Gospel Center Rescue Mission Homeless Expansion Funding Request (4/5ths Vote Required)

RECOMMENDATION

Discuss funding an Expansion Funding Request by Gospel Center Rescue Mission (GCRM) Homeless Growth Proposal for a 178 bed facility (which includes Low Barrier & Expanded Recuperative Care) to address the current Homelessness crisis in Stockton and San Joaquin County. Any funding of this proposal is subject to the successful completion of an environmental review of the project and resolution of any subsequent issue. **(4/5ths Vote Required)**

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION

Chairman Patti has been working with Mr. Wayne Richardson at Gospel Center Rescue Mission in San Joaquin County on a request for \$2.0 million for a construction expansion program.

The Board will discuss a potential dedicated use of funds as it relates to a proposed expansion of GCRM's homeless shelter location and the anticipated buildout of this project.

FISCAL IMPACT

Upon approval by the Board, \$2.0 million will be transferred from the unprogrammed Capital Outlay funds #37004 to the Operating Transfers Budget #1010804000 to provide a contribution of up to \$2.0 million to the GCRM.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN FOLLOWING APPROVAL

Following the discussion and approval by the Board, direct the County Administrator to appropriate the approved amount.
