**Board Approves Supervisor Rickman’s Proposal to Provide \$7,920 From Supervisorial District 5 Funds to United Veterans Council of San Joaquin County to Help Cover Costs of Hosting the ‘The Moving Wall - Stockton 2026’ Event**  
Supporting Local Veterans Organizations

STOCKTON – At its Board meeting on Tuesday, April 14, 2026, the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors approved Supervisor Rickman’s proposal to provide \$7,920 to United Veterans Council of San Joaquin County – via fiscal sponsor United Way of SJC – to help cover security costs for The Moving Wall at Weber Point Event Center in Stockton from May 14–18, 2026.

The Moving Wall is the only half-size replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C., honoring more than 58,000 U.S. service members who lost their lives in the Vietnam War. The memorial site will be open 24 hours a day and free to the public, providing veterans, families, students, and community members, a meaningful opportunity to reflect, learn, and remember. The week will also include opening and remembrance ceremonies, educational opportunities for local schools, and related community events.

“It is an honor to secure funds to cover the security costs for an event of such consequence. The Moving Wall presents a solemn opportunity for our veterans to remember, memorialize, and heal. It also presents an opportunity for our community to gain historical perspective, and recognize, honor, and thank our veterans for their service and sacrifice,” said Fifth District Supervisor Robert Rickman.

The Supervisorial District Funds were re-established by the Board of Supervisors in the 2023-2024 Adopted Budget, to afford each supervisor the opportunity to address district-specific unmet needs. Supervisorial district-funded projects are subject to existing County policy and business practice.
