San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors Recognize Local Veterans
Fifth District Honoree Army Lieutenant Colonel Brian Lucid

STOCKTON – At their meeting Tuesday, May 13, 2025, the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors held their Annual Veterans Recognition Ceremony. This year, Supervisor Rickman honored Mountain House resident, Mr. Brian Lucid.

Lieutenant Colonel Brian Lucid served in the United States Army for 22 years, and after retiring from active duty, was employed at Ft. Hunter Liggett as an Army Civilian until recently. Born in San Francisco, Brian was raised in the Bay Area until he graduated San Jose State and was selected for Active Duty with the U.S. Army. His service took him all over the United States and around the world in places like Germany, Korea, and some of excursions to Haiti, Kuwait, Iraq, Honduras and other various locations. Brian excelled as an infantryman and was eventually transferred to logistics due to the needs of the Army.

Brian is an active member of Post 1537 VFW in Tracy, where he is the Post Service Officer. He is the Program Director for the Knights of Columbus from St. Bernard's Parish in Tracy. He served as a Director on the Mountain House Community Services District Board of Directors. Brian lives in Mountain House with his wife Indra, their son Orrey and dog June Carter Cash. Brian's daughter Hanna is in San Jose working at the Fremont School for the Blind.

Afterward, Supervisor Rickman stated, "It is fitting that we recognize and honor our veterans in May this year, as we mark the 80th Anniversary of the end World War II. Also, in the coming days and months, we will observe Memorial Day in remembrance and honor of those who made the ultimate sacrifice for our freedoms, and celebrate the 250th anniversaries of the Army, Navy, and Marine Corps. It was a privilege to honor and recognize Mountain House resident Brian Lucid, for his service to our nation and his continued service to our community."
