LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY: MAKING YOUR VOICE HEARD

Supervisor Robert Rickman and Fire Chief Randall Bradley Visit PG&E Emergency Operations and Grid Control Centers

On Friday, August 1, 2025, South San Joaquin County Fire Authority Chief Randall Bradley and I met with key PG&E personnel and toured the utility's Emergency Operations Center and Grid Control Center. The visit comes in the wake of a recent Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) event that left residents in several San Joaquin County cities without power from June 19–21 and was an opportunity to directly address these concerns and gain further insight into PG&E's decision-making process during PSPS events.
