- Single with income less than \$1,005 per month.
- Joint income less than \$1,353 per month.

- ✓ You may only be a member of **ONE** brown bag site.
- ✓ Sign-ups are done at each location.
- ✓ Bring proof of age and income.
- ✓ You must sign up to ensure you receive a bag.
