## Fay Vieira Appointed as San Joaquin County Behavioral Health Services Director

**Stockton, CA** — On November 18, 2025, the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors approved the appointment of Fay Vieira as the new Director of Behavioral Health Services (BHS), effective December 1, 2025.

Vieira has served as the County's Interim BHS Director since April 2025 and brings more than 17 years of experience in behavioral health, including extensive leadership in clinical operations, program development, and children and youth services.

Vieira holds a Master's Degree in Counseling, Marriage, Family and Children Counseling from California State University, Sacramento, and is a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist. She earned her Bachelor's Degree in Psychology from UC San Diego.
