

I, the undersigned, say, on information and belief, that in the County of SAN JOAQUIN, State of California:

COUNT 1: MURDER PC.187(A)

On or about March 15, 2022, in the County of San Joaquin, California, CHRISTINA LYN GARNER and JEREMY WAYNE JONES, did commit the crime of MURDER, in violation of Section 187(a) of the Penal

Code, a FELONY, who at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully and intentionally and with malice aforethought murder JUSTIN LARKIN PEOPLES, a human being. It is further alleged that the above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(1).

INTENTIONAL DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM GBI/DEATH PC.12022.53(D)

It is further alleged that CHRISTINA LYN GARNER personally and intentionally discharged a firearm, to-wit: HANDGUN which proximately caused great bodily injury and death to JUSTIN LARKIN PEOPLES within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.53(D).

USE OF FIREARM IN COMMISSION OF FELONY PC.12022.5(A)

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant CHRISTINA LYN GARNER personally used firearm(s), within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1203.06(a)(1) and 12022.5(a) and also causing the above to become a serious felony pursuant to Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(8).

USE OF DEADLY OR DANGEROUS WEAPON PC.12022(B)

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant(s), JEREMY WAYNE JONES personally used a deadly and dangerous weapon(s), to wit: KNIFE said use not being an element of the above offense, within the

meaning of Penal Code Section 12022(b).

It is further alleged that in t

ARMED WITH A FIREARM PC.12022(A)

It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant, JEREMY WAYNE JONES, was armed with a firearm, to wit: HANDGUN, said arming not being an element of the above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022(a).

SPECIAL CIRCUM: MURDER DUE TO RACE/COLOR/REL. PC.190.2(A) (16)

It is further alleged that the murder of JUSTIN LARKIN PEOPLES was COMMITTED by defendant(s), CHRISTINA LYN GARNER and JEREMY WAYNE JONES, who was intentionally killed because of said person's race, color, religion, nationality or country of origin, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 190.2(a)(16).

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense from but connected in its commission with the charge(s) above, complainant further complains and says:

COUNT 2: FELON/ADDICT POSSESS/ETC FIREARM PC.29800(a)(1)

On or about March 15, 2022, in the County of San Joaquin,
California, CHRISTINA LYN GARNER, did commit the crime of
FELON/ADDICT POSSESS/ETC FIREARM, in violation of Section
29800(a)(1) of the Penal Code, a FELONY, who at the time and place

last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully own, purchase, receive or have in his/her possession or under his/her custody or control a firearm, to-wit: HANDGUN, and said defendant having theretofore been duly and legally convicted of a felony or felonies, to-wit: the crime of MAKE/PASS FICTITIOUS CHECK in violation of Section 476 of the PENAL Code on FEBRUARY 8, 2000 by and before the SUPERIOR Court, County of SAN JOAQUIN State of CALIFORNIA; #CR-1999-0008052; the crime of VEHICLE THEFT AND CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT CRIME in violation of Sections 10851(A) AND 182.1 of the VEHICLE AND PENAL Codes on FEBRUARY 8, 2022 by and before the SUPERIOR Court, County of SAN JOAQUIN State of CALIFORNIA, #CR-1999-0016839; AND the crime of FORGERY: FALSE CHECKS/RECORDS/CERTIFICATES/ETC. in violation of Section 470(D) of the PENAL Code on APRIL 23, 2001 by and before the SUPERIOR Court, County of SAN JOAQUIN State of CALIFORNIA, #CR-2000-0017379.

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense from but connected in its commission with the charge(s) above, complainant further complains and says:

COUNT 3: ACCESSORY PC.32

On or about March 15, 2022, in the County of San Joaquin,
California, CHRISTOPHER ANGELO DIMENCO, did commit the crime of
ACCESSORY, in violation of Section 32 of the Penal Code, a FELONY,
who at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and

unlawfully, having knowledge that a felony had been committed in connection with the MURDER of JUSTIN LARKIN PEOPLES did harbor, conceal or aid a principal to the commission of such felony with the intent that said principal avoid or escape from arrest, trial, conviction or punishment for said felony.

If the above-named defendant(s) is/are presently on probation in San Joaquin County, any evidence presented at a preliminary hearing in the instant case will be used not only as a basis for a holding order in this case but also as evidence of a violation of probation and, at any formal hearing on that violation of probation, the People will move the transcript of the preliminary hearing into evidence as a basis for the violation.

Pursuant to Penal Code Section 1054.5(b), the People hereby informally request that the defendant and his/her attorney disclose to the People all information and materials described in Penal Code Section 1054.3.
