

21 I, the undersigned, say, on information and belief, that in the
22 County of SAN JOAQUIN, State of California:

24 **COUNT 1: MURDER PC.187(A)**

25 On or about March 15, 2022, in the County of San Joaquin,
26 California, CHRISTINA LYN GARNER and JEREMY WAYNE JONES, did commit
27 the crime of MURDER, in violation of Section 187(a) of the Penal
28

1 Code, a FELONY, who at the time and place last aforesaid, did
2 willfully and unlawfully and intentionally and with malice
3 aforethought murder JUSTIN LARKIN PEOPLES, a human being. It is
4 further alleged that the above offense is a serious felony within
5 the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(1).

8 **INTENTIONAL DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM GBI/DEATH PC.12022.53(D)**

9 It is further alleged that CHRISTINA LYN GARNER personally and
10 intentionally discharged a firearm, to-wit: HANDGUN which
11 proximately caused great bodily injury and death to JUSTIN LARKIN
12 PEOPLES within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.53(D).
13

14 **USE OF FIREARM IN COMMISSION OF FELONY PC.12022.5(A)**

15 It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted
16 commission of the above offense, the said defendant¹ CHRISTINA LYN
17 GARNER personally used firearm(s), within the meaning of Penal Code
18 Section 1203.06(a)(1) and 12022.5(a) and also causing the above to
19 become a serious felony pursuant to Penal Code Section
20 1192.7(c)(8).

23 **USE OF DEADLY OR DANGEROUS WEAPON PC.12022(B)**

24 It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted
25 commission of the above offense, the said defendant(s), JEREMY WAYNE
26 JONES personally used a deadly and dangerous weapon(s), to wit:
27 KNIFE said use not being an element of the above offense, within the
28

1 meaning of Penal Code Section 12022 (b) .

2
3 **ARMED WITH A FIREARM PC.12022 (A)**

4 It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted
5 commission of the above offense, the said defendant, JEREMY WAYNE
6 JONES, was armed with a firearm, to wit: HANDGUN, said arming not
7 being an element of the above offense, within the meaning of Penal
8 Code Section 12022(a) .

11 **SPECIAL CIRCUM: MURDER DUE TO RACE/COLOR/REL. PC.190.2 (A) (16)**

12 It is further alleged that the murder of JUSTIN LARKIN PEOPLES was
13 COMMITTED by defendant(s), CHRISTINA LYN GARNER and JEREMY WAYNE
14 JONES, who was intentionally killed because of said person's race,
15 color, religion, nationality or country of origin, within the
16 meaning of Penal Code Section 190.2(a) (16) .
17

19 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different
20 offense from but connected in its commission with the charge(s)
21 above, complainant further complains and says:
22

23 **COUNT 2: FELON/ADDICT POSSESS/ETC FIREARM PC.29800 (a) (1)**

24 On or about March 15, 2022, in the County of San Joaquin,
25 California, CHRISTINA LYN GARNER, did commit the crime of
26 FELON/ADDICT POSSESS/ETC FIREARM, in violation of Section
27 29800(a) (1) of the Penal Code, a FELONY, who at the time and place
28

1 last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully own, purchase, receive
2 or have in his/her possession or under his/her custody or control a
3 firearm, to-wit: HANDGUN, and said defendant having theretofore been
4 duly and legally convicted of a felony or felonies, to-wit: the
5 crime of MAKE/PASS FICTITIOUS CHECK in violation of Section 476 of
6 the PENAL Code on FEBRUARY 8, 2000 by and before the SUPERIOR Court,
7 County of SAN JOAQUIN State of CALIFORNIA; #CR-1999-0008052; the
8 crime of VEHICLE THEFT AND CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT CRIME in violation
9 of Sections 10851(A) AND 182.1 of the VEHICLE AND PENAL Codes on
10 FEBRUARY 8, 2022 by and before the SUPERIOR Court, County of SAN
11 JOAQUIN State of CALIFORNIA, #CR-1999-0016839; AND the crime of
12 FORGERY: FALSE CHECKS/RECORDS/CERTIFICATES/ETC. in violation of
13 Section 470(D) of the PENAL Code on APRIL 23, 2001 by and before the
14 SUPERIOR Court, County of SAN JOAQUIN State of CALIFORNIA, #CR-2000-
15 0017379.

19 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different
20 offense from but connected in its commission with the charge(s)
21 above, complainant further complains and says:
22

23 **COUNT 3: ACCESSORY PC.32**

24 On or about March 15, 2022, in the County of San Joaquin,
25 California, CHRISTOPHER ANGELO DIMENCO, did commit the crime of
26 ACCESSORY, in violation of Section 32 of the Penal Code, a FELONY,
27 who at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and
28

1 unlawfully, having knowledge that a felony had been committed in
2 connection with the MURDER of JUSTIN LARKIN PEOPLES did harbor,
3 conceal or aid a principal to the commission of such felony with the
4 intent that said principal avoid or escape from arrest, trial,
5 conviction or punishment for said felony.
6

7
8 If the above-named defendant(s) is/are presently on probation in San
9 Joaquin County, any evidence presented at a preliminary hearing in
10 the instant case will be used not only as a basis for a holding
11 order in this case but also as evidence of a violation of probation
12 and, at any formal hearing on that violation of probation, the
13 People will move the transcript of the preliminary hearing into
14 evidence as a basis for the violation.
15

16
17 Pursuant to Penal Code Section 1054.5(b), the People hereby
18 informally request that the defendant and his/her attorney disclose
19 to the People all information and materials described in Penal Code
20 Section 1054.3.

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I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct except for those things stated on information and belief and those I believe to be true.
