17 accuses the Defendant(s) of committing, in the County of San  
18 Joaquin, State of California, before the finding of this Indictment,  
19 the following crime(s):

22 **COUNT 1: ASSAULT BY PUBLIC OFFICER PC.149**

23 On or about December 30, 2020, in the County of San Joaquin,  
24 California, MICHAEL STILES and OMAR VILLAPUDUA did the crime of  
25 ASSAULT BY PUBLIC OFFICER, in violation of Section 149 of the Penal  
26 Code, a FELONY, who at the time and place last aforesaid, did as a  
27 public officer, acting under color of authority and without lawful

1 necessity, assault another, to-wit: DEVIN CARTER.

3 **INFLICTION OF GREAT BODILY INJURY PC.12022.7(A)**

4 It is further alleged that in the commission of the above offense  
5 the said defendant(s), MICHAEL STILES , personally inflicted great  
6 bodily injury upon DEVIN CARTER , not an accomplice to the above  
7 offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.7 and also  
8 causing the above offense to be a serious felony within the meaning  
9 of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c) (8).

12 **INFLICTION OF GREAT BODILY INJURY PC.12022.7(A)**

13 It is further alleged that in the commission of the above offense  
14 the said defendant(s), OMAR VILLAPUDUA , personally inflicted  
15 great bodily injury upon DEVIN CARTER , not an accomplice to the  
16 above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.7 and  
17 also causing the above offense to be a serious felony within the  
18 meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c) (8).

21 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different  
22 offense from but connected in its commission with the charge(s)  
23 above, complainant further complains and says:

25 **COUNT 2: ASSAULT WITH FORCE LIKELY TO PRODUCE GBI PC.245(a) (4)**

26 On or about December 30, 2020, in the County of San Joaquin,  
27 California, MICHAEL STILES and OMAR VILLAPUDUA did commit the crime  
28 of ASSAULT WITH FORCE LIKELY TO PRODUCE GREAT BODILY INJURY, in

1 violation of Section 245(a)(4) of the Penal Code, a FELONY, who at  
2 the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully  
3 commit an assault upon DEVIN CARTER by means of force likely to  
4 produce great bodily injury.
