
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SUBJECT: Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Agency Report on the Exclusive Emergency Ambulance Provider Contract Compliance for American Medical Response (AMR) for the months of November and December 2006.

The EMS Agency Report on the Exclusive Emergency Ambulance Provider Contract Compliance for AMR for the months of November and December 2006 represents the fourth opportunity to report on AMR's performance under their five year contract. The AMR contract establishes accountability for meeting specific standards and provides the EMS Agency with complete access to data and information on AMR's operational, clinical, and administrative performance. EMS Agency staff has vetted AMR's computer aided dispatch (CAD) data in preparing the compliance report and performing its response time analysis of AMR's November and December 2006 performance.



AMR's combined response time compliance for all ambulance zones met or exceeded the 90 percentile standard set by the County, 92.48% for November and 92.06% for December.

AMR continues to make improvements in the mean response times in the urban and suburban areas of

zones A-2, A-3, B-4, and B-5. However, performance remains outside the County's response time standards. The EMS Agency is working with AMR to analyze the potential impact of incorrectly assigned population densities may be having on the low compliance numbers in

these areas. By contract the County and AMR must annually review the population density assignments in all zones and make adjustments as appropriate.

An emerging issue facing the EMS system is the growing problem of delays in transferring care in the emergency department. In some hospitals the transfer of care has exceeded four hours while six or more ambulance crews continued to treat their patients in emergency department hallways waiting for the hospital to accept their patients. The EMS Agency anticipates AMR requesting significantly more response time exemptions as a result of this practice for the months of January and February 2007.


