

The EMS Agency Report on the Exclusive Emergency Ambulance Provider Contract Compliance for AMR for the months of January and February, 2011, represents the twentyninth opportunity to report on AMR's performance under the five year contract. The County's contract with AMR establishes accountability for meeting specific standards and provides the EMS Agency with complete access to data and information on AMR's operational, clinical, and administrative performance.

AMR's January and February 2010, response time compliance for all ambulance zones met or exceeded the 90 percentile standard set by the County with 93.70% for January and 92.62% for February.




