

Ripon Fire District Exclusive Operating Area Ambulance Contract Compliance SUBJECT:

The EMS Agency Report on the Exclusive Emergency Ambulance Provider Contract Compliance for Ripon Consolidated Fire District (RCFD) for the months of May and June 2021, provides an in-depth review of RCFDs performance. The County's contract with RCFD establishes accountability for meeting specific standards and provides the EMS Agency with complete access to data and information on RCFD's operational, clinical, and administrative performance. Performance data in the table below are the result of combining two months in order to ensure that a minimum of 100 responses are measured for statistical relevance.



On July 21, 2020, the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors approved the agreement with American Medical Response - West (AMR) for exclusive emergency and advanced life support (ALS) service in ambulance zone X for the period May 1, 2021, to May 1, 2026. As part of one of the revisions in the renewed agreement, the compliance subzones in zone X were reconfigured from eleven to six. A revised exclusive operating areas (EOA) zone map is attached.

RCFD's response time compliance exceeded the 90th percentile standard set by the County for May with 92.63% and June with 93.83%. The combined two-month percentile with 176 responses for May and June was 93.23%.
