Per EMT 2010 the employing agency of the EMT has first right of refusal for any and all EMT Certification action investigations. Any investigation that may lead to an EMT Certification Action must be communicated to the EMT's employing Agency for discussion and investigation. The revisions of policy 2700 with the new wording changes appear to try to circumvent the EMT Certification action process and create a "loop hole" to allow the San Joaquin County EMS Agency to keep employing agencies out of the loop on a investigation of there employees.	Policy 2700 was revised to address local authorizations only. Not EMT certification.
