Subj: Rate Increase for Emergency Ambulance Services in Ambulance Zone D  
Effective May 1, 2024

Dear Mr. Caldera:

This letter is to inform you that San Joaquin County Emergency Medical Services Agency (SJCEMSA) is in receipt of your request to increase allowable emergency ALS ambulance rates dated, February 13, 2024. As specified in Section 10.2 Billing and Collections and Exhibit F of Manteca District Ambulance Service (MDAS) agreement, rates shall increase by 4% effective on May 1, 2024, as shown below. MDAS's maximum allowable emergency ALS ambulance rates will increase as follows:

Category	Current MDA Rates	MDA Rates as of May 1, 2024
ALS Emergency Base Rate	\$3,586.32	\$3,729.77
BLS Emergency Base Rate	\$3,058.44	\$3,180.78
Night Charge	\$253.02	\$263.14
Oxygen	\$321.18	\$334.03
Mileage (per loaded mile)	\$76.10	\$79.14
EKG/Cardiac Monitor	\$101.45	\$105.51

As specified in Section 11.13 of the Agreement MDAS's contract monitoring fee will be adjusted based on the same percentage of increase authorized in the ambulance rate. Effective December 1, 2024, MDAS's contract monitoring rate will be \$28,121.60.
