TITLE: Trauma Center Team Activation

EMS Policy No. 4720

#### PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to establish requirements for trauma center team activation.

#### **AUTHORITY:**

Health and Safety Code, Division 2.5, Sections 1797.220, 1798, 1798.162, 1798.163, 1798.164, 1798.165, 1798.168, 1798.170, and 1798.172. California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9, Chapter 7.

### **DEFINITIONS:**

A. "SJCEMSA" means the San Joaquin County Emergency Medical Services Agency.

## POLICY:

- I. Designated trauma center shall develop a written policy establishing a tiered response for activating trauma team members. This policy shall be consistent to EMS Policy No. 3415, <u>Trauma Center Notification</u> and must be approved by the SJCEMSA. In the absence of an SJCEMSA approved policy authorizing a tiered trauma team response designated trauma centers shall ensure a full trauma team response, including the attending trauma surgeon, to the trauma resuscitation area or patient bedside upon the receipt of a trauma center notification from prehospital personnel per EMS Policy No. 3415, <u>Trauma Center Notification</u>.
- II. Response requirements for qualified specialist and services are specified in EMS Policy No. 4712, Level II <u>Trauma Center Standards</u> and EMS Policy No. 4713, <u>Level III Trauma Center Standards</u>.
- III. Trauma team activation and response shall be measured to ensure that unnecessary delays are identified and addressed through the CQI/PIPS process.
