Course Topics:

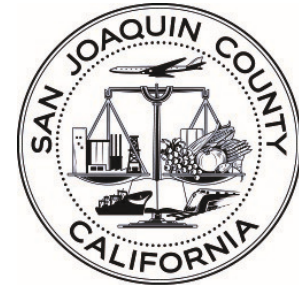
- Explain how major incidents engender special management challenges.

- ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300, IS-700 and IS-800

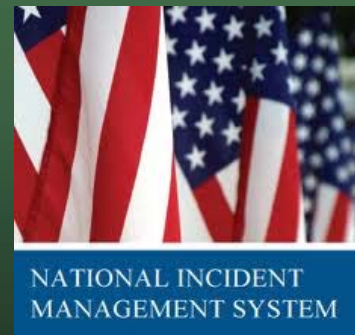
Tuition:
