- Develop an incident action plan for a simulated incident.

- ICS-100, ICS-200, IS-700, IS-800

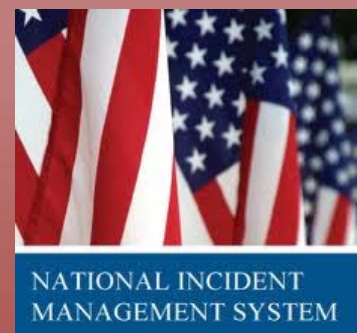
## Tuition:
