
Incident Map

## **Incident Planning Process for Extended Operations**

## **Course Supplies and Materials:**

- 1. Tables and chairs for each eight person team
- 2. LCD projector and screen
- 3. Laptop computer with speakers (for instructor)
- 4. One wall size ICS-215 and ICS-215A for each team
- 5. One wall size incident map for each team
- 6. One wall size ICS-207 or HICS-207 for each team (optional)
- 7. One roll of 2" painters tape, to secure charts to the walls
- 8. Two flip chart pads and easels for each team
- 9. Marking pen, for flip charts
- 10. Dry erase pens for the ICS-215 and ICS-215A
- 11. Ink pens, pencils, and note pads or legal pads for each participant
- 12. One Participant Handbook for each participant
- 13. One set of Command and General Staff position vests for each team
- 14. One Field Operations Guide (FOG) ICS-420-1 or applicable chapter for each participant

- 16. Access to a photo copier, to make 12 copies of the completed Incident Action Plan (IAP) for each team

- 18. Food and drinks. Depending upon the course schedule selected the team may need to work through lunch.
