This half-day course trains emergency responders and healthcare personnel to select and use the appropriate instrument for a radiological/nuclear incident. Participants will learn the basic operation and application of survey instruments, dosimeters, personal radiation devices, radio-isotope identification devices and portal monitors. For the experienced operator, this course provides a refresher on multiple radiation detection platforms.

Attendees are encouraged to bring their own agency/organization's instruments if possible. This course uses sealed radioactive sources to provide realism.
