Course Description:

Radiological Dispersal Device (RDD) Train the Planner, is a management level training program for all State, Local, Tribal and Territorial (SLTT) personnel responsible for the planning and execution of critical response plans. The course provides critical decision makers with the tools required to establish the framework for an RDD response plan and assists in the identification of training and resource gaps that may impact the jurisdictions ability to effectively respond.

Using the <u>Radiological Dispersal Device (RDD) Response Guidance; Planning for the First 100 Minutes</u>, participants collaborate with each other to identify capabilities and shortfalls while laying the groundwork for an effective and comprehensive response plan.

Participants will become proficient in use of the RDD Response Guidance as a research and development reference tool using while using it as a guide to identify and incorporate the appropriate radiological technical data, emergency tactical response recommendations, and public protection strategies during course sessions to development an operable RDD response plan.
