NEW CLASS - ADVANCED ASTL

Ambulance Strike Team Leader Course

Eligible for Position Task Book (PTB) credit

This advanced, scenario-based course builds on the foundational Ambulance Strike Team Leader (ASTL) training and is designed for trainees who are actively completing their Position Task Book (PTB). This one-day, 8-hour program immerses participants in complex, scenario-driven exercises aligned with the 32 tasks of the official ASTL Position Task Book (PTB). Through collaborative group simulations, participants will refine decision-making, communication, and coordination under pressure. This training may be applied toward both renewal and initial ASTL packets. This training is optional and not required for recertification.

Eligibility requirements to be uploaded at registration to attend:

- Proof of completion EMSA's ASTL / MTF Course after October of 2023
- Proof of completion for ICS-300: Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents
- Proof of completion for G606: Standardized Emergency Management Systems (SEMS)
- Letter of Support signed by the participant's supervisor authorizing attendance
