SUBJECT: Proposed Hourly Rate and Minimum Hourly Fee Increase

As part of the budget process, all Environmental Health Department (EHD) fees are reviewed and evaluated to ensure revenues generated from fees are appropriate and sufficient to meet the expected costs of each program. This ongoing evaluation process is especially important as many EHD program requirements are constantly changing with the passage of new laws, regulations, and policies.

In 1990, the Board of Supervisor's passed Resolution B-90-620, which endorsed a policy of full cost recovery for the EHD. As such, all EHD fees are evaluated, and adjustments proposed in order to meet this goal. For fiscal year 2023-24, fee increases in the Liquid Waste Program, Cottage Food Class B (Direct/Indirect Sales), and Body Art (Temporary Event Mobile Facility) Program are proposed for minimum hourly charge to increase to close the current, significant gap between program revenues and net county cost. The EHD hourly rate is also proposed to increase from \$156 to \$162. The proposed fee changes are provided below.

This opportunity for public and industry comment is being provided in preparation for the public fee hearing to be held before the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors, scheduled for Tuesday, June 06, 2023, in the Board Chambers of the County Administration Building, 44 North San Joaquin Street, Stockton, California.
