Please be advised that the San Joaquin County Environmental Health Department (EHD) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Lovelace Transfer Station. The EHD is the Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for this facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites in San Joaquin County.

### Description of Project and LEA's Determination

Lovelace Transfer Station is a 15-acre existing transfer station located at 2323 Lovelace Road west of Union Road, north of Manteca. On June 25, 2025, the LEA received an application package proposing to amend the Report of Facility Information (RFI) as part of the Five-Year Permit Review.

The amendment proposes to add the Short-Lived Climate Pollution Reduction (SB-1383) organic materials required measurements and calculations and the use of an existing fourth scale.

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with the State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facility permit. The LEA approved the amendment on July 1, 2025.
