Please be advised that the San Joaquin County Environmental Health Department (EHD) received and approved a Transfer Processing Report (TPR) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Lovelace Transfer Station. The EHD is the Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for this facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites in San Joaquin County.

Description of Project and LEA's Determination

Lovelace Transfer Station is a 15-acre existing transfer station located at 2323 Lovelace Road West of Union Road, North of Manteca. On May 8, 2026, the LEA received a Solid Waste Facility Permit package from the San Joaquin County Department of Public Works applying for a TPR amendment.

The amendment proposes the establishment of a containerized self-haul recycling area at the self-haul green waste area. The proposal includes the use of an access gate for commercial vehicles that carry recyclable loads. Additionally, the commercial green waste tipping and loading area will be relocated to the south processing area.

The proposed changes are expected to reduce backups, improve service for customers and encourage recycling and appropriate disposal of green waste. In addition, the change would significantly improve safety by designating separate processing areas for commercial and private green waste vehicles.

The EHD finds that the proposed change is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), is consistent with the State Minimum Standards for Transfer/Processing Facilities and does not conflict with the terms and conditions of the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP). The EHD approved the amendment on May 13, 2026.
