Side Letter

San Joaquin County and San Joaquin County Sheriff Deputy Sergeant Association

[Subject to approval by the Board of Supervisors.] San Joaquin County (County) and the San Joaquin County Sheriff Deputy Sergeant Association (SDSA) representing employees in the Sheriff Sergeants bargaining unit, agree that employees may, depending on assignment, be scheduled to work 84 regular hours per pay period. Section 5.1 of the existing Memorandum of Understanding is amended to include the following subsection titled 5.1.1 84 Plan Schedule. This 84-hour schedule will become effective at the discretion of the County.

5.1.1 84 Plan Schedule

For employees scheduled for eighty-four (84) regular hours per pay period the base compensation shall be deemed to be compensation per bi-weekly pay period of eighty-four working hours. This base compensation shall be payment in full for all services rendered to the county except as otherwise provided.
