


TEMPORARY WORK SUSPENSION AND PROJECT STATUS UPDATE



BENJAMIN HOLT DRIVE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

Due to unfavorable weather conditions for paving operations, major construction activities on the Benjamin Holt Drive Pavement Rehabilitation Project have been suspended until Spring 2026. Temporary traffic striping has been applied to delineate travel lanes during the suspension period. Permanent striping will be installed upon completion of the project.



To date, approximately 70 % of the project has been completed.

Remaining work includes reconstruction of roadway base materials from Plymouth Road to Belmont Place; placement of the final asphalt concrete surface from Plymouth Road to Leesburg Place; installation of permanent traffic striping; and other miscellaneous items of work.

A follow-up notification will be provided when roadway construction resumes. Construction crews may be on site during the winter to address miscellaneous non-weather dependent work. San Joaquin County Public Works appreciates your patience and cooperation as we work to complete this project. We also extend warm wishes to you and your family for a wonderful holiday season.
