**SUBJECT: COLONIAL HEIGHTS AND LINCOLN VILLAGE MAINTENANCE
DISTRICTS WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT PHASE 1B**

Dear Resident:

The San Joaquin County Department of Public Works is pleased to announce the next phase of water system improvements in the Colonial Heights and Lincoln Village Maintenance Districts, as shown on the enclosed Vicinity Maps. The Project includes the installation of approximately 4,900 linear feet of new water mains, water service laterals, fire hydrants, and meter boxes. Water service connections will be relocated to the front of each property, and the existing water mains and service lines located within residential backyards will be abandoned. This Project will not include the installation of any meters.

Construction is anticipated to begin on or around August 17, 2026, beginning in the Colonial Heights neighborhood. Preliminary activities, such as potholing to identify underground utilities and establishing the alignment of the new water main, are anticipated to occur before full construction begins.

Construction will be completed in stages, and the contractor may begin work in Lincoln Village before completing all work in Colonial Heights to help keep the Project on schedule. As a result, residents may see crews working in their neighborhood at different times throughout the construction period. All work is expected to be completed by the end of December 2026, weather permitting.

Typical work hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, with weekend work as needed.

During construction, some roads may be temporarily closed to through traffic; however, residential access will be maintained at all times. Temporary restrictions to driveway access and on-street parking may be necessary during construction activities. Driveway access will be restored by the end of each workday, and any after-hours on-street parking restrictions will be limited to those necessary to support construction activities.

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While some dust should be expected during the construction period, the contractor will implement measures to minimize and control dust to reduce impacts on the surrounding area. Residents may also experience brief water service interruptions during final utility connections and cleaning operations; however, the contractor will provide advance notice before any planned water service interruptions.
