Project Features:

- Splitter islands to slow down intersection-approaching vehicles
- One lane rural roundabout
- Center island with wide truck apron for use by extra-large vehicles and equipment



Project Benefits:

- Reduction in collisions and property damage
- Reduction in crash severity
- Reduction in traffic delay on minor street (Duncan Road)
- Increased capacity for large vehicle turning movements
- Improved air quality

Public Outreach:

- Regular updates to the Farm Bureau on the status of the Project, including its purpose and need, and features
- Field demonstration in July 2018 to allow local farmers to try various size vehicles/equipment
- Converses with several constituents directly via phone and email to discuss project's scope, goals, and objectives
- Community Open House Meeting on November 8, 2021 and Linden Municipal Council (MAC) Meeting on September 20, 2023



Schedule:

- Duration: September 5 through December 29, 2023, weather permitting.
- Work hours: 6:30 am to 6:30 pm, Monday through Friday.
- Potential nighttime work/closures

Project Cost/Funding:

- Construction = \$2,397,000
- 100% Funded by the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)
