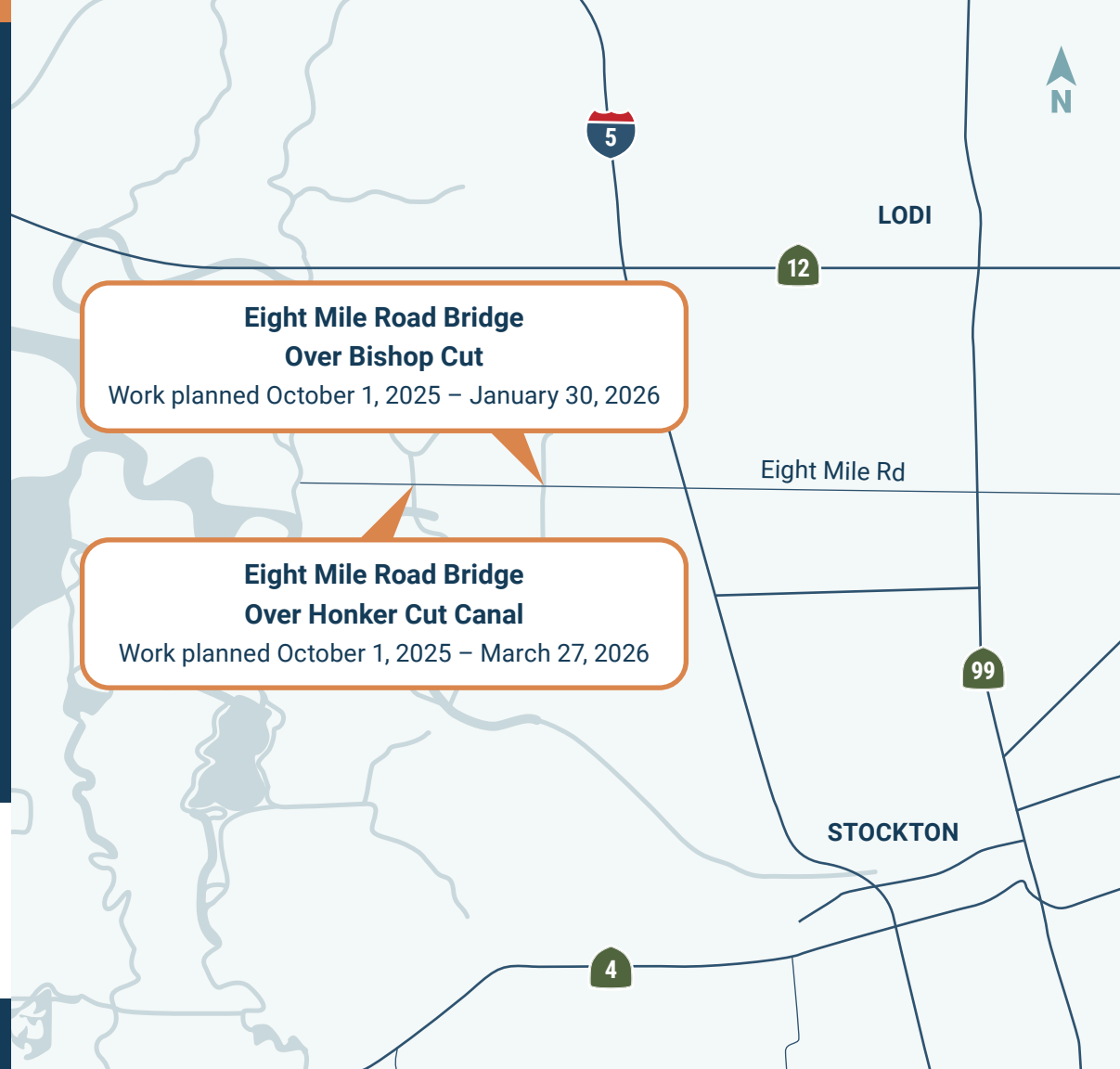


PROJECT STATUS UPDATE

The **Eight Mile Road Bridges** over Bishop Cut and Honker Cut are scheduled to be closed to marine traffic beginning October 1 for Phase 2 construction.



TEMPORARY BRIDGE CLOSURE TO MARINE TRAFFIC

On October 1, 2024, the San Joaquin County Department of Public Works (SJC Public Works) began a project to rehabilitate the mechanical and electrical systems on four movable-span bridges in the Sacramento-San Joaquin River Delta. Phase 1 work has been completed on the Bacon Island Road Bridge over Middle River and the Tracy Boulevard Bridge over Grant Line Canal, and the waterways are open to all marine traffic. Phase 2 work will begin October 1, 2025.

Upcoming Work | Phase 2

Eight Mile Road Bridge over Bishop Cut

- Closed from October 1, 2025, through January 30, 2026

Eight Mile Road Bridge over Honker Cut Canal

- Closed from October 1, 2025, through March 27, 2026

During this time, both bridges will be closed to marine vessels that require a bridge opening. Passage for small vessels where bridge openings are not required will be maintained. Vehicular traffic will continue to be accommodated, but motorists should expect intermittent one-lane closures during construction activities.

Construction activities during this period will generally occur from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, with occasional night work. Construction message boards or signs will be placed in advance to provide additional details.
