
PROJECT STATUS UPDATE

Bacon Island Road Bridge over Middle River has been completed, and the waterway is now open to all marine traffic.

Eight Mile Road Bridge over Honker Cut Canal will remain temporarily closed to marine traffic through June 26, 2025 (Phase 1 construction).







TEMPORARY BRIDGE CLOSURE TO MARINE TRAFFIC

On October 1, 2024, the San Joaquin County Department of Public Works (SJC Public Works) began a project to rehabilitate the mechanical and electrical systems on four movable-span bridges in the Sacramento-San Joaquin River Delta with an expected completion date of January 31, 2026. Since October 1, 2024, work has been focused on the Bacon Island Road and Tracy Boulevard bridges, and Phase 1 work on the Eight Mile Road bridge (over Honker Cut). Work on the Tracy Boulevard Bridge over the Grant Line Canal and the Bacon Island Road Bridge over the Middle River has been completed, and both waterways are open to all marine traffic.

Work on the following bridge requires an extended closure:

• Eight Mile Road Bridge over Honker Cut Canal through June 26, 2025 for Phase 1 construction. Phase 2 work will be performed from October 1, 2025 – January 31, 2026.

Passage for small vessels through the Honker Cut Canal, where bridge openings are not required, will be maintained.

Vehicular traffic will continue to be accommodated: however, one-lane closures should be expected during construction activities. Construction activities will generally occur from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, with occasional night work. Advance construction message boards or signs will be in place to provide additional details.
