

## **CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE BUCKMAN ROAD BRIDGE NO. 29C-307 REPLACEMENT**

### **Project Description:**

The San Joaquin County Department of Public Works (SJCDPW) will be requesting proposals from consultant firms to provide construction management services for the **Buckman Road Bridge No. 29C-307 Replacement Project** (Project), also known as **Federal Aid Project No. BRLO – 5929(241)**. The requested services will be performed in accordance with the Highway Bridge Program and Caltrans' Local Procedures Manual (LAPM).

The project involves replacing the current Buckman Road Bridge (Br. No. 29C-307) with a new bridge over North Fork Duck Creek Branch. The replacement work includes, but is not limited to:

- Remove the existing one-lane bridge structure
- Construct a new cast-in-place (clear-span) bridge, consisting of a one 12-foot-wide travel lane with 6-foot shoulders to accommodate agricultural equipment
- Construct a temporary bypass bridge and stream diversion system
- Drive concrete piles for the bridge foundation
- Install rock slope protection in the channel
- Construct concrete bridge barriers
- Construct approach guardrails and install end terminals
- Reconstruct the roadway approaches
- Reconstruct adjacent access roads

The bridge will measure approximately 43-6" feet in length and 25-6" feet in width.

SJCDPW will enter into a consultant services agreement with the selected consultant to provide construction management/contract administration services for the Project. The requested services will include the following, but are not limited to:

- Constructability Review
- Construction Management/Contract Administration
- Part-time Resident Engineer (California license)
- Full-time Construction Inspection
- Coordination with Stakeholders/Permitting Agencies
- Project Records Services
- Material Sampling and Testing
- Labor Compliance
