

CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE ESCALON-BELLOTA ROAD BRIDGE NO. 29C-476 REPLACEMENT

Project Description:

The San Joaquin County Department of Public Works (SJCDPW) will be requesting proposals from consultant firms to provide construction management services for the **Escalon-Bellota Road Bridge No. 29C-476 Replacement** (Project), also known as Federal Aid Project No. BRLS – 5929(238). The requested services will be performed in accordance with the Highway Bridge Program and Caltrans' Local Procedures Manual (LAPM).

The project involves replacing the current Escalon-Bellota Road Bridge (Br. No. 29C-038) with a new bridge over Littlejohns Creek. The replacement work includes, but is not limited to:

- Erecting a temporary detour bridge adjacent to the existing structure
- Establishing temporary creek diversion systems/cofferdams upstream and downstream of the work area
- Clearing vegetation/trees to facilitate the work
- Installing falsework to facilitate the construction of the bridge
- Constructing new roadway approaches
- Constructing a bridge drainage system
- Installing a new guardrail system
- Implementing rock slope protection along the creek banks adjacent to the new bridge abutments
- Restoring riparian habitat

The new bridge (29C-476) will measure approximately 135 feet in length and 35 feet in width.

SJCDPW will enter into a consultant services agreement with the selected consultant to provide construction management/contract administration services for the Project. The requested services will include the following, but are not limited to:

- Constructability Review
- Construction Management/Contract Administration
- Part-time Resident Engineer (California license)
- Full-time construction Inspection
- Coordination with Stakeholders/Permitting Agencies
- Project Records Services
- Labor Compliance
