

## **“ON-CALL” CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SUPPORT SERVICES**

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### **Project Description:**

The San Joaquin County Department of Public Works (SJCDPW) will solicit qualifications from construction management firms to provide a range of construction support services for various transportation projects. These services may include, but are not limited to, construction inspection, Resident Engineer services, constructability and project plan reviews, and other related services, such as public outreach, biological and environmental services, arborist services, surveying and construction staking.

The transportation projects encompass various initiatives, including roadway resurfacing/reconstruction/rehabilitation/widening, sidewalk installation/replacement, and bridge repairs/rehabilitation, involving substructure and superstructure repairs, as well as guard or barrier rail replacement.

While registration as a professional engineer is desirable, it is not mandatory for the resident engineer. The requested professional services will generally involve short-term projects, typically ranging from fifteen (15) to seventy-five (75) working days.

The intent is to establish a list of three (3) to four (4) qualified construction management firms to provide services on an on-call, as-needed basis. The specific scope of work and required completion schedules will vary with each specific project assignment. The list will be utilized by SJCDPW for a two-year period with the option for SJCDPW to extend the period for an additional year.

### **Services Needed:**

- Resident Engineer (California License preferable)
- Construction Inspections
- Construction document review (constructability/project plan reviews)
- Public Outreach
- Arborist Services
- Biological/Environmental Services (e.g., Monitoring)
- Surveying (3D modeling of topographic surveys is desirable, but not required)
- Construction Staking
