Project Description:

San Joaquin County Department of Public Works (SJCDPW) will request qualifications from engineering consulting firms to provide materials engineering and testing services in conjunction with roads and streets, bridges, traffic signals, water, sanitary sewer, storm drainage, and other public works projects.

SJCDPW will select one or more of the most qualified firms to be assigned work on an on-call, as needed basis. The amount of the services provided by each selected firm is not anticipated to exceed \$200,000 per year over an initial two-year period with the possible extension to a third year.

Services Needed:

The services to be provided by the selected firm(s) include, but are not limited to, analysis utilizing the *California Test Methods (CTM)* of the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) Transportation Laboratory (TransLab), and American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) standards. Registration as a professional engineer licensed in the State of California and Caltrans material testing, sampling, and lab certification are required.

The statement of work, the cost proposal, work schedule and duration of assigned tasks will vary and will be developed at the time each assignment is made. Some work tasks may be assigned on short notice and require immediate action. Other project assignments may involve extended work durations.

Release of Request for Qualifications (RFQ): February 2026

Qualified consulting engineering firms that wish to be considered must respond to the RFQ, which will be released by SJCDPW in February 2026. Questions may be directed to Awni Taha as indicated above. Following the release of the RFQ, all inquiries from interested firms will be referred to SJCDPW staff members who oversee the selection.
