

“ON-CALL” LAND SURVEYING SUPPORT SERVICES

Project Description:

The San Joaquin County Department of Public Works (SJCDPW) will solicit qualifications from qualified land surveying firms to provide professional and technical land surveying support services for a variety of Public Works design and construction projects throughout San Joaquin County. These services will be provided on an “on-call,” as-needed basis and may include, but are not limited to, topographic surveying, right-of-way surveying, construction surveying and staking, roadway stationing, establishment of survey control, bench circuits, corner records, records of survey, channel surveying, and other related land surveying services.

The transportation and infrastructure projects may encompass a variety of improvements, including roadway resurfacing, reconstruction, rehabilitation, and widening; bridge replacement and rehabilitation; scour mitigation; channel improvements; embankment and slide repairs; and other Public Works infrastructure improvements.

Professional surveying services shall be performed under the responsible charge and supervision of a California-licensed Land Surveyor. The selected consultant shall have the capability to provide field surveying, data collection, survey control, construction staking, and related surveying deliverables in support of both design and construction activities.

Surveying assignments may range from relatively small, short-duration tasks to more comprehensive surveys supporting roadway, bridge, and channel projects. Typical assignments may include roadway topographic surveys ranging from approximately 0.5 to 6 miles in centerline length, roadway reconstruction projects generally less than one mile in length, and channel surveys extending several hundred feet upstream and downstream of bridge structures.

The intent is to establish a list of three (3) to four (4) qualified land surveying firms to provide services on an on-call, as-needed basis. The specific scope of work and required completion schedules will vary with each specific project assignment. The list will be utilized by SJCDPW for a two-year period with the option for SJCDPW to extend the period for an additional year.
