

Pavement Condition Assessment for San Joaquin County Roads

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Project Description:

San Joaquin County (County) is seeking proposals from qualified firms to provide professional services to perform a pavement condition assessment for approximately 692 miles of road and prepare a five (5)-year pavement management plan (optional task). Proposers must have sufficient expertise and experience to complete the work as described

Services Needed:

- Physically evaluating the pavement condition of the designated County roads and determining a Pavement Condition Index (PCI) for each road segment
- Measuring and scoring roadway segments for roughness per the International Roughness Index (IRI)
- Identifying feasible rehabilitation alternatives for each roadway section, if necessary
- Creating an Excel and GIS database with a summary of PCI and recommended improvements, including costs
- Prioritizing projects and preparing a recommended five (5)-year pavement management plan within a set budget

Solicitation Start Date:

A Request for Proposals will be released in May 2026, and the project is scheduled to begin in September 2026.
