Project Description:

San Joaquin County Department of Public Works will be soliciting proposals from civil/transportation consulting engineering and planning firms for the August Sustainable Community Plan (Plan). The Plan will focus on sustainable transportation improvements by centering on existing and future community assets and needs related to accessible health, nutrition, education, human services, housing assistance, and employment opportunities around the August community. The Plan will focus on facilitating the movement of people and goods between job centers and the community through alternative modes of transportation. The requested services will include implementing extensive outreach, proposing complete street designs, evaluating circulation and making recommendations, and identifying investment strategies for future project construction.

The Plan's study area, in general, is bounded by the Stockton Diverting Canal to the north, State Route (SR) 99 to the east, Fremont Street to the south, and Wilson Way to the west.
