UNACCEPTABLE WASTE

Septic tank waste; some types of construction/demolition
waste*; toxic materials; dead animals; drums larger than
5 gallons; Infectious waste; liquid waste; cannery waste;
hazardous waste; ammonia refrigerant unit; logs and tree
stumps; used cooking oil from commercial haulers; burned
wastes; large loads of concrete, soil, rocks, gravel, or asphalt;
pressure treated, and creosote coated wood.
***Items of sufficient weight, mass, hardness or difficulty in
processing that may damage facility equipment*

RATES

Customers with UNCOVERED/UNSECURED LOADS must pay a double disposal fee or purchase a tarp.

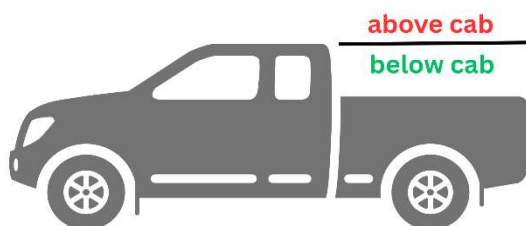

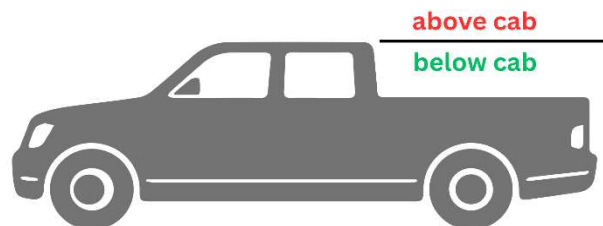

Residents: Motorcycle, passenger, small truck tires Up to Four (4) Per Trip @ No Charge

Loader Tires: No larger than 23.5 x 25..... \$169.75 ea.

Earth Moving Tires: Larger than 23.5 x 25..... \$509.25 ea.

Appliances (e.g., A/C Units, Freezers, Refrigerators)

Residents: Up to Two (2) Per Trip @ No Charge

Residents: Additional or Unemptied units per load, any combination..... \$20 ea.

Businesses/Non-Residents: Units per load, any combination..... \$20 ea.

E-Waste (e.g., TVs/CRTs/Computer Monitors)

Residents: Up to Four (4) Per Trip @ No Charge

Residents: Additional units per load, any combination..... \$23.75 ea.

Businesses/Non-Residents: Units per load, any combination..... \$23.75 ea.

Mattress or Box Spring

Residents:..... Up to Ten (10) Per Trip @ No Charge

Residents: Additional units per load..... \$20.00 ea.

Businesses/Non-Residents:

Normal weighed waste fees apply to entire load, up to limit of 30 units....\$78.78 per ton. (Min. charge at \$38.50)

E-Waste/U-Waste (e.g., Fluorescents/Batteries/Electronics/Car Batteries)

Residents: any combination, no additional units accepted..... Up to Nine (9) Per Trip @ No Charge.

SPECIAL HANDLING FEES:

Large Bulky Items/Hard-to-Handle \$123.97 per ton. (Minimum charge at \$38.50)

Items including but not limited to: Mobile homes, RV trailers, camper trailers 25 feet or less in length (remove thermostats and appliances, dismantle the camper/trailer/vehicle into small sections, and bring a Junk Slip from DMV), boats, large concrete, wire, tree stumps, large/long pipes, drip hoses and large wooden/metal beams.
