

# ▶ GRANT LINE ROAD REALIGNMENT PROJECT

Lead Agency: San Joaquin County



## ● SCOPE

Grant Line Road will be realigned in a southerly direction toward 11th Street and South Bird Road, where it will connect via a two-lane roundabout. A new roadway will be added to connect Bird Road to Grant Line Road. Additionally, South Bird Road north of 11th Street will dead-end just before 11th Street. Grant Line Road will have four 12 feet wide travel lanes with a 14-foot-wide median. The median either will be landscaped or will accommodate 12-foot-wide left-turn lanes near intersections with local roadways. The three existing at-grade railroad crossings will be closed and a new at-grade railroad crossing at the new four-lane Grant Line Road will be constructed. The existing Grant Line Road/G Street intersection will be modified to improve operations and pedestrian enhancements will be added to the existing Grant Line Road at-grade crossing.
