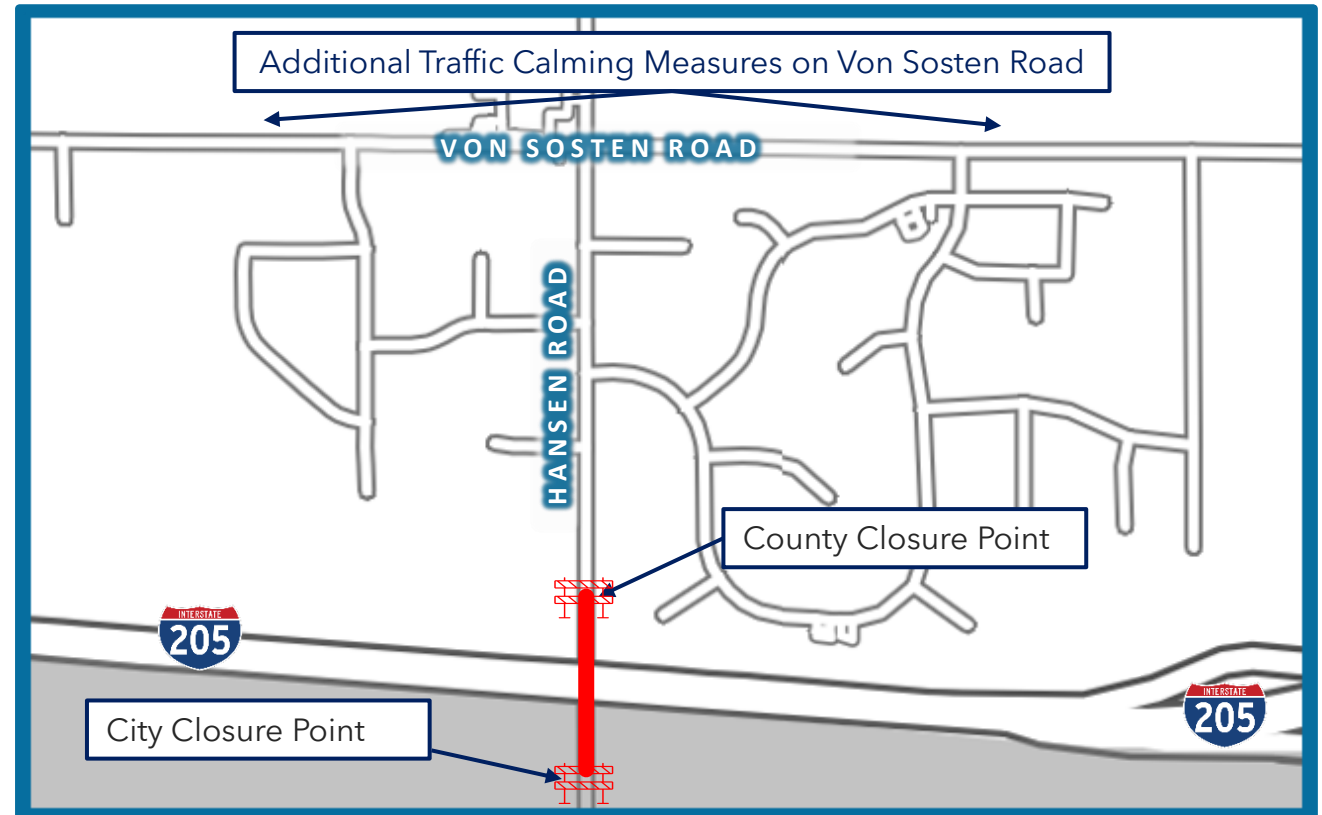
## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HANSEN ROAD

## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AGENCY COORDINATION

- Meetings with County Counsel, California Highway Patrol, Sheriff's Department, City of Tracy/Prologis, and South San Joaquin Fire Authority
- CHP and Sheriff's Office unable to determine serious and continual criminal activity
- County Counsel determined most appropriate and applicable California Vehicle Code Section (21101(e))
- Fire Authority primarily concerned with potential delays
- City of Tracy required to have Council approve temporary closure in their jurisdiction



# TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE PROPOSED PHASE I TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES



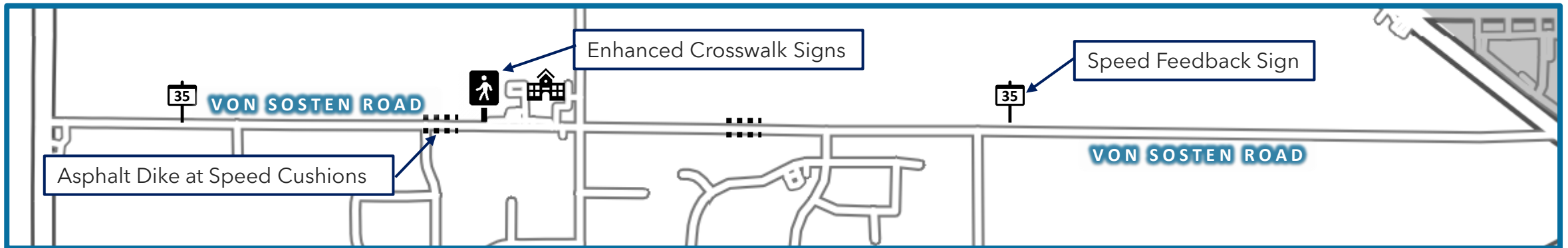
Speed Feedback Signs



Enhanced Crosswalk Signs w/ Rapid Flashing Beacons

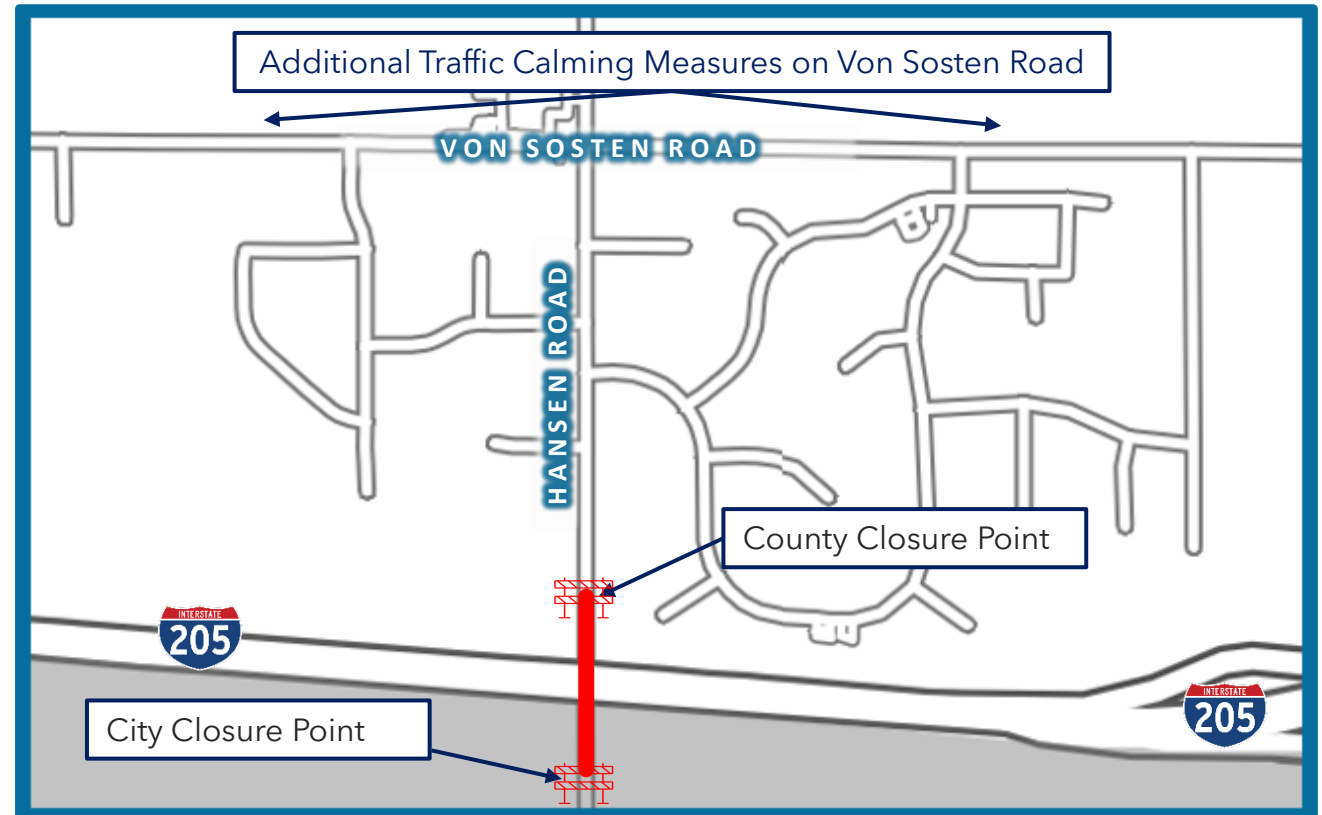


Asphalt Dike at Existing Cushions



## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE RECOMMENDATION & NEXT STEPS

- Temporary Closure for up to 18 months
- Implement traffic calming measures concurrently
- If approved, Public Works will coordinate with the City of Tracy to implement closure after City Council approval. Implementation currently estimated by January 2023, weather permitting
- Public Works will review and report traffic impacts during closure period and report findings to your Board
