San Joaquin County has Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) on file for reference in making map determinations for properties located within County Special Flood Hazard Areas (SFHA). As a public service and upon request, Water Resources staff will assist with providing the following information:



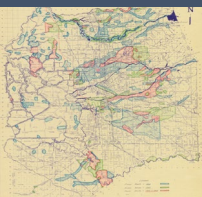
Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) Information

- Flood zone determination
- Base flood elevation (BFE) and depths when available
- Floodplain or Floodway determination



Elevation Certificate Information (EC)

- Certification of construction standards in flood zones
- EC information is public information (*personal information redacted*)



Historic Flood and Area Soil Map Information

- 1955 & 1958 Historic Stream and Flood Map
- Expansive and Subsidence Soil Areas



Flood Insurance Purchase Requirement Information

- Handouts are available upon request explaining Flood Insurance purchase requirements for properties with Federally-backed mortgages, mortgage re-finance or property loans for structures located inside the San Joaquin County Special Flood Hazard Areas
