



**2024 Presidential Primary Election  
One Percent Manual Tally - Random Precinct Selection**

On March 6, 2024, the San Joaquin County Registrar of Voters office conducted the 2024 Presidential Primary Election One Percent Manual Tally, Random Precinct Selection. The selection was carried out using a random number generator, ensuring impartiality and accuracy in the chosen precincts. A total of 9 precincts were selected for the manual tally:
