Newsworthy San Joaquin County Facts & Figures

Voters

- As of October 10, 2022, approximately 385,000 voters are eligible to vote in San Joaquin County.

Polling Locations and Poll Workers

- **178** polling places
- **206** mail ballot precincts
- **384** total precincts
- **Approximately 1,500** poll workers assigned to 178 polling locations, which includes over 300 student poll workers from San Joaquin County school districts.

Ballot Drop Box Hours and Locations

Ballot drop boxes are located at:

- 25 locations throughout San Joaquin County
- The San Joaquin County Administration Building has two locations: one outside the Weber Street door entrance and one inside the 3rd Floor Suite 350 Registrar of Voters (ROV) office.
- Starting October 10, 2022, through November 7, 2022, drop boxes will be available during the location's business hours.
- On Election Day Tuesday, November 8, 2022, ALL ballot drop boxes will be available from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- All ballot drop boxes will be closed and locked at 8:00 p.m. on Election Night November 8, 2022.

Other ballot drop-off options include San Joaquin County's *Drive Up Democracy!* location located at 44 N San Joaquin Street, Stockton available on Election Day between 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The *Drive Up Democracy!* location allows voters to drop off their ballots without exiting their vehicles.

Election Results

- Initial Election night results will post at approximately 8:00 p.m. These results will include Vote by Mail ballots received through Saturday, November 5, 2022.



- Tabulation of ballots from the precincts will take place at the ROV Warehouse at 7585 Longe Street, Suite 112 in Stockton. There will be a specific media, observer, campaign check-in and **viewing area which is open to the public.**
- Additional results from the polls will begin at 10:00 p.m. unofficial results will be updated approximately every two hours until all precincts have reported. Following Election Night, Results will be reported every Tuesday by 7 p.m. until completion (*NOTE: ROV may post weekly results sooner if appropriate*). Results can be found at: www.sjcrov.org or www.sos.ca.gov.
- The ROV has until December 8, 2022 to certify the 2022 General Election.

Stockton East Water District Race

- Due to a clerical error, voters in the [Stockton East Water District](#) (SEWD) should have received a supplemental ballot with updated information for the SEWD races only. They should mark both the original ballot as well as the supplemental ballot so their vote will be counted in the SEWD races. Only SEWD votes cast on the supplemental ballot will be counted toward those races.

Tips for Stress-Free Voting

- Visit the San Joaquin County website at www.sjcrov.org for detailed information.
- Thoroughly read the information on the voter pamphlet, weigh the pros and cons of each issue and learn the candidates' qualifications. Complete sample ballots ahead of time, if possible before going to the polls.
- Know where your polling place is located. It may have changed since the last election.
- Voters who are in line before 8:00 p.m. will be allowed to cast their ballots.
- The SJC Registrar of Voters strongly recommends for voters to be patient and give themselves enough time to vote.
- Those who arrive after 8:00 p.m. will miss their chance to vote.

Most Common Errors Made

- Voters forgetting to vote the entire ballot
- Voters forgetting to put all cards in the return envelope
- Voters forget to sign their ballot envelope and include their home address.
- **Voters should ensure their envelope is signed if mailing in their ballot or dropping it off at a polling location or drop box.**
